

BOTH WORLD SCIENCE FICTION CONVENTION – 2022 SITE SELECTION BALLOT

Rules (please read carefully):

Eligibility: To be eligible to vote, you must be a living, natural person and either a Full Attending or Supporting Member of CoNZealand. Ballots cast for memberships held by non-natural persons, such as “Guest of” memberships, clubs, toys, et cetera, may only be voted as “No Preference.” Please note that Day Passes do NOT include voting rights.

If you do not have a membership and want to vote, you may purchase a Supporting Membership on the CoNZealand website (members.conzealand.nz/memberships). CoNZealand memberships cannot be purchased via a ballot submitted by mail.

You must also pay an Advance Supporting Membership (Voting) Fee of NZ\$72 to vote in the 2022 Worldcon site selection. Payment may only be made online, using your credit card, on the CoNZealand website.

Follow the instructions on the website at members.conzealand.nz/reservations. Please use the subpage for paying the voting fee for the Worldcon site selection. You will receive a voting token; enter it on your ballot as proof of payment.

NO CHEQUES OR CASH ARE ACCEPTED BY MAIL.

Postal ballots must be received by Monday, 13 July, 2020.

You may cast your signed ballot by postal mail, or as a PDF by email, sent to: siteselection2022vote@conzealand.nz.

PDF ballots must be received by Wednesday, 29 July, 2020, 12:00 pm (noon) Wellington time.

Voting: Site Selection ballots are tallied by preferential balloting procedures. The winner is the first option to receive a majority of those ballots expressing a preference. Indicate your favourite selection with a “1,” your next favourite with a “2,”

4. After filling out both sections of the ballot and signing it, fold the ballot along the dashed lines below, then tape the fold shut at the solid line, in order to conceal your vote from casual viewing prior to the ballot count.
